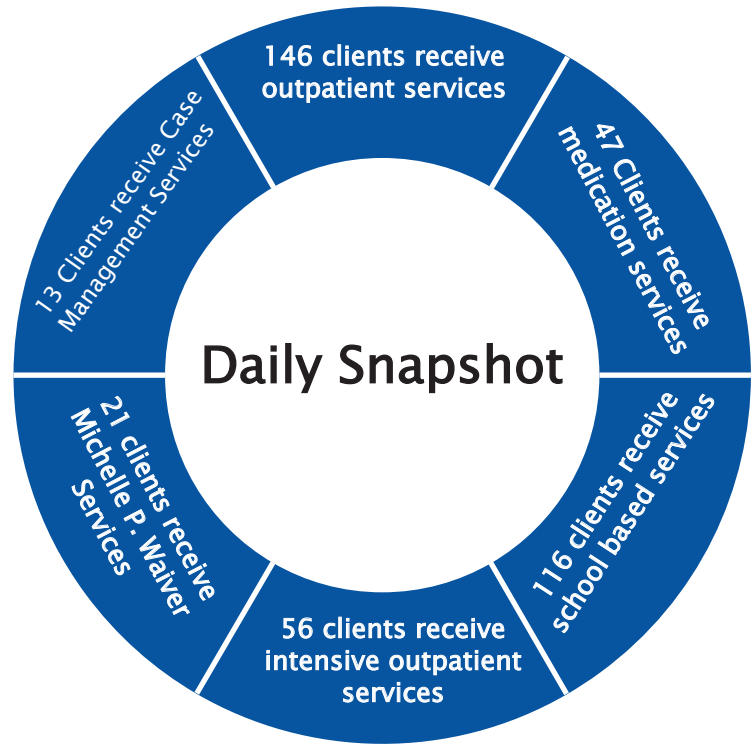
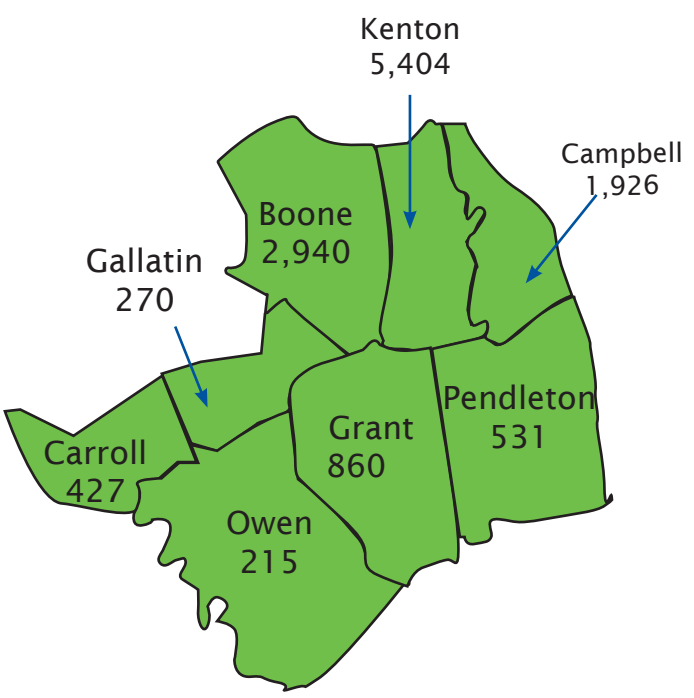

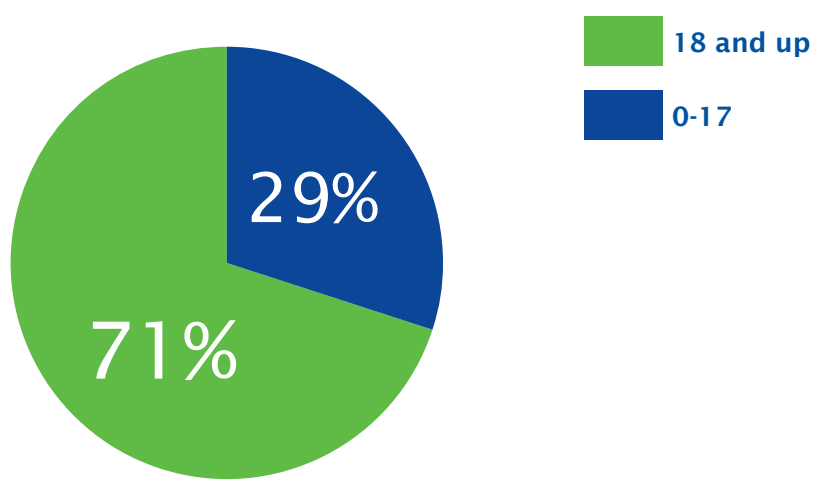

## Clients Served by County



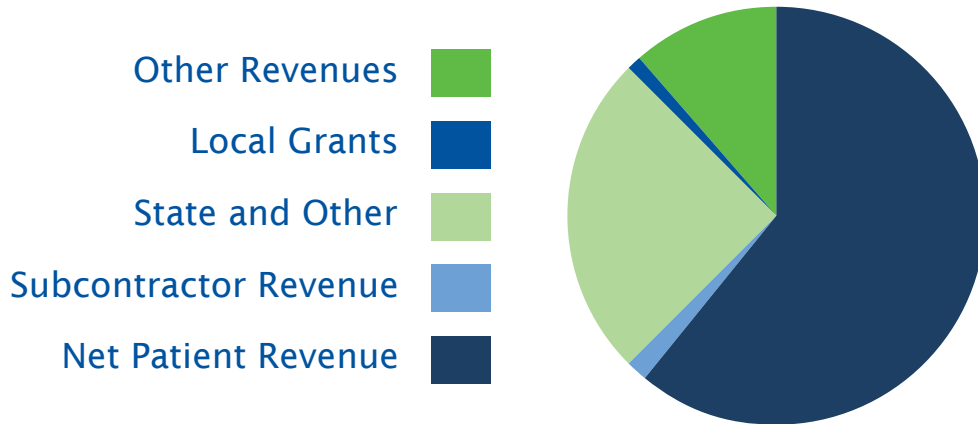
## Clients Served By Age



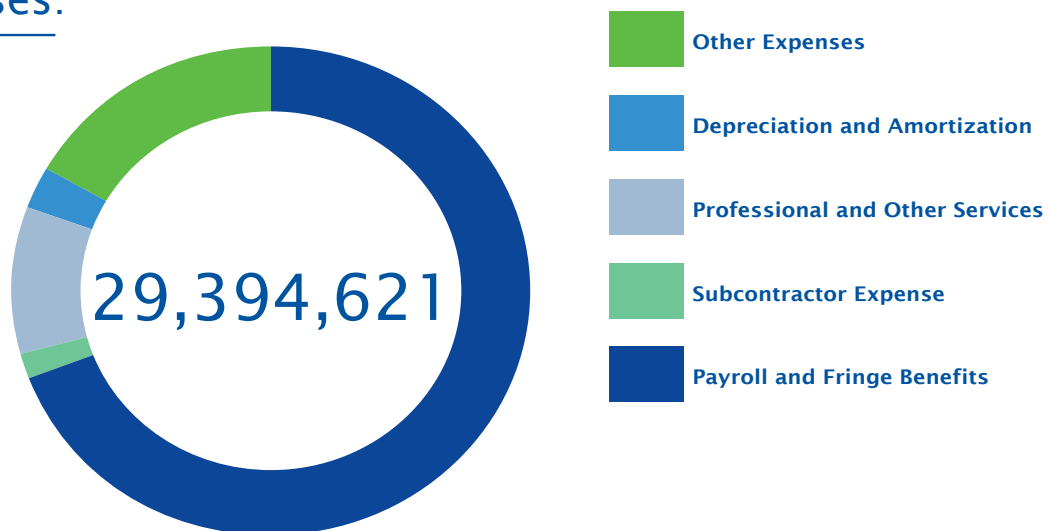

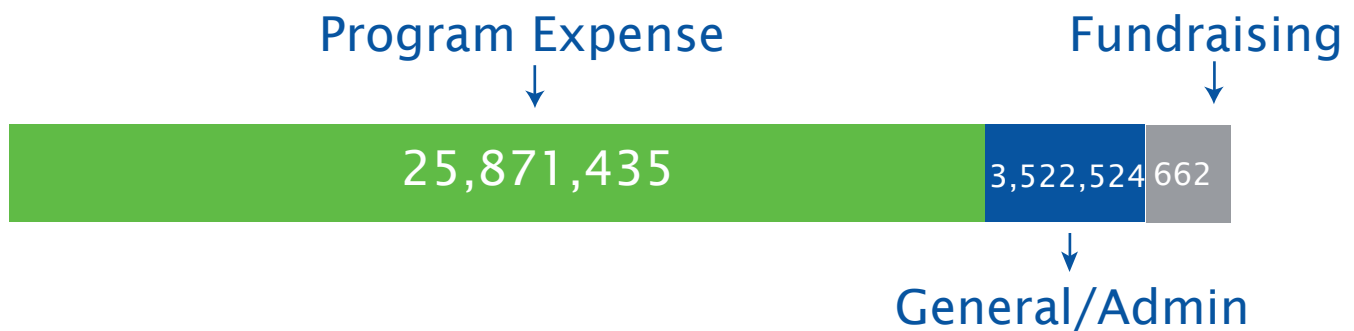
Total Revenue: 36,346,241
